General Service Board News

Board Activities: The joint A.A.W.S/AAGV Board meeting that took place during the 69th GSC included discussions of collaboration opportunities with staff and service desks, unified ordering, ERP, and shared governance regarding online sales, YouTube apps, etc. Our Trustees are developing recommendations to clarify floor action protocols at the GSC. The next GSB quarterly meeting will be held in Rye Brook, NY, from November 2-4, 2019. This will be preceded on November 1 by a meeting of the A.A.W.S. Board, which will also gather on December 6 following its Strategic Planning meeting on December 5. Our Trustees, Non-Trustee Directors, and Appointed Committee Members stay very busy volunteering their services to A.A.

ERP: The Enterprise Resource Planning system is converting the old Fellowship New Vision group records database to the NetSuite *My Portal* software. We can expect disruptions in our Area Registrar's capacity to access group information during this upgrade process.

IT Services: An International A.A. Data Map will be added to aa.org once an interface with the new ERP NetSuite system has been developed. GSO plans to launch a Meeting Finder service on the upgraded aa.org website, once customer support functions can be clarified. Our local intergroups have requested a decentralized procedure for answering customer questions, since GSO does not have the information or the resources to handle that function.

Literature: Our Big Book is now available in 71 languages, with 23 languages pending, 16 new translations in process, and 5 revisions/ retranslations. The 12 & 12 is available in 48 languages, with a pending translation in Arabic & a revised Czech translation. *Daily Reflections* is currently printed in 34 languages.

Public Information: P.I. is working with Publishing to develop postcard-style service pieces with brief excerpted content about A.A.
